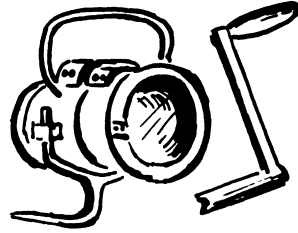
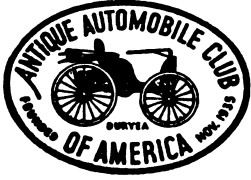

ONTELAUNEE REGION BUSINESS MEETING APRIL 2021

President Marilyn Roth welcomed Ontelaunee Region AACA members to a business meeting by Zoom on April 3, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. We recited the pledge of allegiance to the American flag.

Susan Manwiller gave the Secretary's report from the business meeting held by Zoom on March 6, 2021. A motion to approve the Secretary's report was made by Tim Hinkle and seconded by Ken Dages. The motion carried unanimously.

Lester Manwiller gave the Treasurer's report for March 2021. A motion to accept the Treasurer's report was made by Cheri Dotterer and seconded by Barry Seel. The motion carried unanimously.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Membership: Phyllis Peters reported 178 members as of tonight. Condolences were sent to the family of Robert Reinert who passed away March 23, 2021. She still has four free AACA memberships available. Two membership rosters were returned. One was where the post office was supposed to hold the person's mail but the roster was accidentally returned to sender and Phyllis has been unable to reach the other person.

Activities: In the absence of Suzy McGovern, Marilyn reminded everyone of the Early Bird Tour scheduled for April 18. Please contact Suzy if anyone is interested in doing a tour.

Das Awkscht Fescht: Matt Manwiller left word with Marilyn that the Fescht is moving ahead full speed. The committee is looking at options for participation awards and entertainment.

Susan Manwiller reported 771 vehicle registrations to date, 30 more than last month. Flea market spaces are 187, 17 more than last month.

Newsletter: Mike Horning has been sending the newsletter to Phyllis and she has been proofing the layout before sending to the printer thereby saving the club \$20 to \$30 a month.

Publicity: Lester had nothing new to report.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Newsletter: Phyllis reported there were 115 newsletters sent in April. The cost is \$1.89 per newsletter. Phyllis is going to call those who get it both ways and ask them to pick either mail or email. Members will also be able to read the newsletter on the website.

2. Website: Phyllis reported that only 23 people sent in their replies opting in to having their roster information on the members' only portion of the website. Phyllis suggested since there would be so few names in the roster, not to put any in. Michael can put the past presidents in if Phyllis can get the information to him digitally. Michael will send the password to members.

NEW BUSINESS

1. May Business Meeting: Marilyn asked if it would be possible to have the May business meeting in person at the church. If the church would allow it, we would still wear masks and socially distance. Cheri said she could livestream the meeting to those at home. After a discussion Cheri Dotterer made a motion to continue by ZOOM until September and then make a decision whether or not to meet at the church. The motion was seconded by Tim Hinkle. The motion carried unanimously.
2. \$500 Donation to National: Since the AACA National meeting has been cancelled for now, Lester wanted to know if he should mail National the donation we have budgeted for them. A motion was made by Ken Dages and seconded by Jeff Dotterer to send AACA the check. The motion carried unanimously.
3. Four-day Tour: Ken Dages is working on a tour to Atlantic City and Cape May in September. We might make hotel reservations on our own and use the club funds for food and entertainment. Ken is considering changing the dates to Sept. 24, 25, 26 & 27.
4. Wheels for Victory: Neil Merkel said his daughter is having a car show and swap meet on May 15, 2021 at the Kempton Community Fairgrounds to benefit Victory Junction, a camp for children with serious medical conditions. The car show will be held from noon till 6:00 p.m. with food, music and other activities. Pre-registration is \$10 till May 10 and \$15 after May 10. If car club members want to park together, put a note with the registration. If we want, we can set-up a table for membership. Any questions, call Neil or his daughter. Information will be put in the May newsletter.
5. Correspondence: Phyllis read a very nice thank you from Teresa Seel for the get well wishes she received.
6. Fund Raiser: Cheri Dotterer said Alvernia University and the Camel Project are having a fund raiser and street fair in Reading on June 5, 2021. Contact Cheri for details.
7. Website: Michael Dotterer will get hold of AACA to delete the old website.

A motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:10 p.m. was made by Cliff Maurer and seconded by Ken Dages. The motion carried unanimously. The next meeting is May 1 at 7:00 p.m. by Zoom.

Our club will be having a tour to Cape May, NJ. We will leave from the Cracker Barrel in Fogelsville on Friday morning, September 24 and return on Monday September 27. Our host hotel will be the Hampton Inn, Egg Harbor Township, NJ near Atlantic City. Room reservations will be made directly with hotel and cost approximately \$135 a night including tax for Friday and Saturday and \$15.00 less for Sunday night. The price includes breakfast each morning.

On Friday we will pack a lunch and visit the Wheaton Glass works in Millville, NJ on the way to our hotel.

On Saturday we will be touring the Cape May Naval Air Museum and the Cold Spring Village.

On Sunday we will be taking a guided Trolley tour of Cape May with an included tour of the Emlen Physick Mansion and the Carroll Gallery, which is having a special exhibit.

On Monday we will be visiting a huge Antique Mall in Smithville, NJ before heading home.

The cost for all four days (not including the hotel) will be approximately \$250-\$300.00 per person. This covers all tours and all meals. Exact pricing is yet to be determined.

Note that you must have E-Z pass for the bridges, Atlantic City Expressway, and Garden State Parkway.
