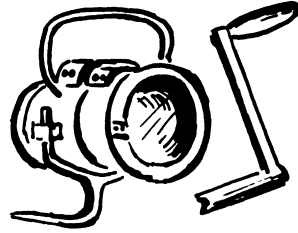
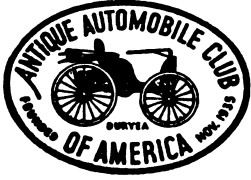

- Always use and display your Ontelaunee Tour Banner. If you do not have one you can purchase one from Phyllis Peters, Membership Chairperson
- If you have a CB Radio we usually use channel 7. This is a great way of keeping in touch with others if problems occur.
- When driving on a tour it is important that you try to keep the car behind you in your sight. This way if there is a problem the tour can stay together.
- Toumasters should always drive at a moderate speed if possible so a tour can be enjoyed.
- When asked to drop out. Always stop at the side of the road. Fall back in when the tail car approaches.
